SEASONAL REGISTRATION AT ABBOTSFORD JUNIORS FOOTBALL CLUB

This document outlines the steps that a prospective member of Abbotsford Juniors Football Club must take to register with the Club. This includes players, coaches, managers, game leaders and volunteers. All members whether they are registering for the first time or an existing member returning to Abbotsford Juniors Football Club must follow the registration process outlined below.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Football Canterbury Association has confirmed that new to football players DO NOT need to register with Football Federation Australia to obtain a FFA number. If you are a coach seeking accreditation for a Football Canterbury Association or Football NSW course, please contact the Club.
- Players returning from a previous seasion (or year) should use their existing Dribl Registration (Connect) account to sign-up. This will ensure that the information you entered last year for any registrations will be made available for returning registration. If you need to setup a new account for any reason (including a change of email address), you will need to know either the First Name, Last Name and Date of Birth of the person being registered as they were registered last year OR FFA number and Date of Birth to complete a member registration search to retrieve their information from their last playing season
- ALL members (returning and new) will need a new passport style photo of the member being registering

Pre-Registration Step - Creating a new Dribl Registration Account (if required)

To register a player, coach or manager with Abbotsford Juniors you must first have a Dribl Registration account. This can be setup at registration.dribl.com.

If you are a new to Abbotsford Juniors player, coach or manager and do not have a Dribl Registration Account, please do the following:

At the home page, select Abbotsford Juniors (Football Club) from the list provided. Click Login on the next page (top right-hand corner) and click the **Create Account** button.

Create a new account by entering your First and Last Name, Email Address, Phone Number and Password.

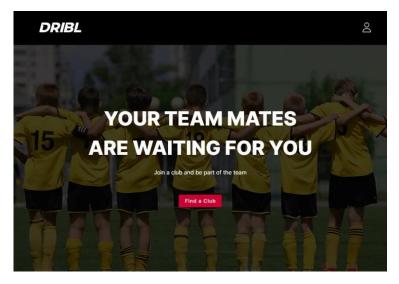
Once complete, you will be sent an Account Activation Email to the email address you nominate. Find the email and click on the link provided to activate your account. This will activate your personal Dribl Registration account which is where you can manage all your registration requests including your own and those of your family where required.

Once you have completed your account setup, you are ready to submit a new registration request.

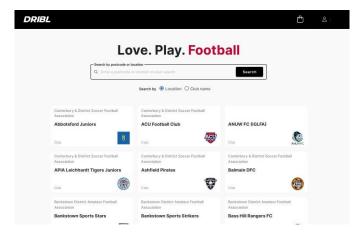
The steps required to create a new registration request are detailed as follows:

Step 1 – Login at registration.dribl.com

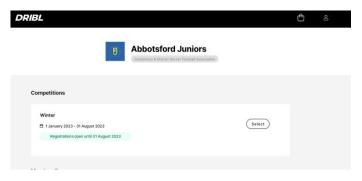
Login to the Dribl Registration website. You will be taken to a Home Page which allows you to select a Club you wish to register with. Click *Find a Club* to show a list of Clubs for registration.



Step 2 – Start a registration with Abbotsford Juniors Football Club Click **Abbotsford Juniors** from the list displayed



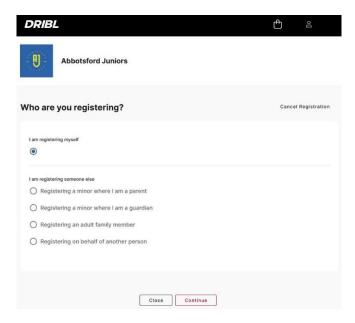
Step 3 – **Select** the relevant competition (i.e. 2024 Winter Competition) to start a registration.



If you are not logged in successfully at this point, you will be prompted to Login. Use your login credentials or create a new account as outlined earlier in the process.

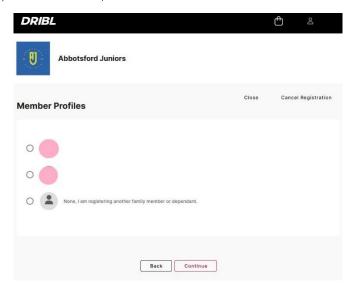
Step 4 – Nominate who you are registering

Select the appropriate option from the list provided noting that if you (as the account owner) are registered as a player, coach or manager, registration for yourself can be selected at this point. Select **Continue**.



If you have previously registered someone using your account:

You will be presented with a list of people who you can select from to progress registration. If the person is not present or is a person who you haven't registered previously, select the *None...* option. Select **Continue**.

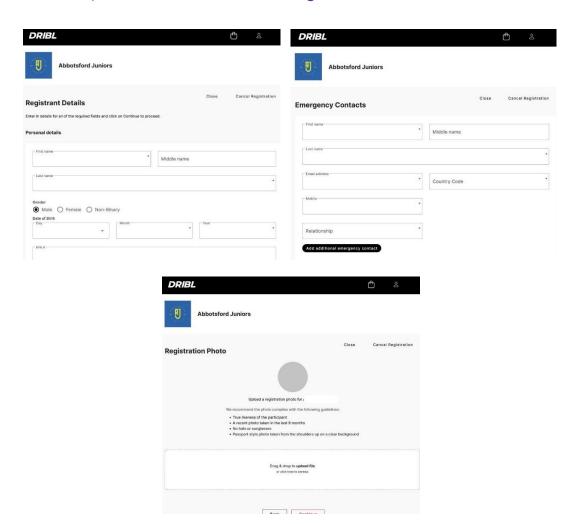


Step 5 – Registrant Detail entry and confirmation.

On completing the previous step, you will be taken to the Registrant Details page. If you selected an existing member profile, many fields will be pre-populated. If you selected *None...*, all fields will need to be completed.

Complete all the required fields in *Registrant Details, Emergency Contacts* and *Registration Photo* pages shown below and ensure a **current** passport sized photo is uploaded.



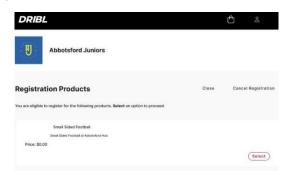


Please keep these guidelines in mind when uploading photos and images:

- Photo is a passport style image
- Head faces camera directly with full face in view
- No hats or sunglasses are to be worn in the photo
- Photo was taken within the last 12 months
- Photo is clear and legible with appropriate lighting
- Under 1 MB in size
- File type of .PNG or .JPG Please

Inappropriate or uncompliant photos WILL result in a registration being declined by the Football Canterbury Association. This will delay your registration and may mean you miss a place in a team with Abbotsford Juniors.

Step 6 – Click on **Next** at the bottom of the screen to take you to the **Products section**. **Select** the Competition Age Group and Gender appropriate that the player wishes to register for this season.



Click on Next at the bottom of the screen to take you to the Additional Questions section and answer any questions that are presented.



These questions may vary dependent upon the age and the membership registration you are requesting. For example, junior and youth players may include questions about the school the player attends, the team or coach the player wishes to play with, Working with Children checks for coaches and managers, past playing detail and an additional information field to provide detail to our Club Registrar to assist with player placement and team formation.

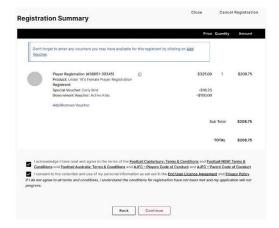

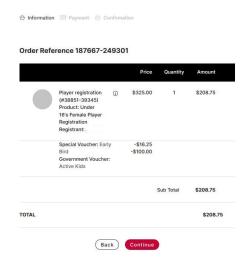
Step 7 – Click on **Next** at the bottom of the screen to take you to the **Registration Summary** section. This will present a summary of the registration requested. Please ensure you read and accept any Terms and Conditions, End User Licence Agreement and Privacy Policy. You must accept all conditions to proceed with a registration.



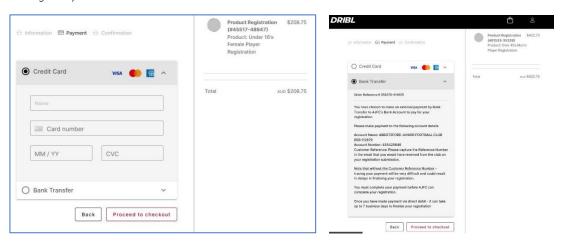
If you are submitting a player registration for a child who qualifies for an NSW Government Active Kids Voucher you may enter it at this time and Click the **Add Voucher**. To obtain a voucher, please visit the Services NSW website application page - <u>Apply for an Active Kids Voucher</u>. If you Active Kids Voucher is validated successfully, the payment total will be adjusted. Select **Continue** to proceed.

At this point, you will be prompted to add another registration (e.g. for another family member) or to Check-Out. Select your required option and process all your required registrations until you are ready to proceed to **Check-Out**.

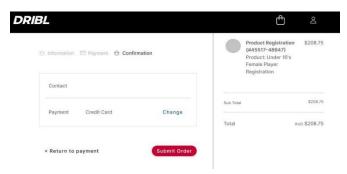
Step 8 – Having selected to **Check-Out** you will be navigated to the Payment process and the *Information Section*. In the first step, Order Summary information will be displayed for all registrations requests you have confirmed. Once you have reviewed the request, select **Continue**.



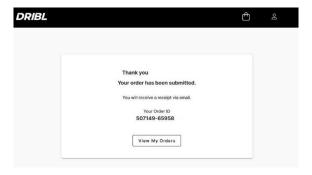
The next step is the *Payment Section*. Two payment options – Credit Card and Bank Transfer may be available. Select your chosen payment method, complete any required information and select **Proceed to Checkout**. Please note that the instructions for Bank Transfer will be provided again in your order confirmation email.



The next step is the Confirmation Section for Order submission. This is the final point at which you can cancel or change your payment or registration information. Once your order is submitted it will be sent to Abbotsford Juniors and a payment processed for your registration(s). Select **Submit Order** to complete the registration process.



Step 9 – On successful completion of the submission you will be taken to a simple confirmation page and a confirmation email will be sent to the email address nominated for your Dribl Registration account. If you have elected to make a payment via credit card, a receipt will also be sent to your nominated email address.



Step 10 – Post Order submission. Once the Club Registrar has reviewed your registration request they will either reject or approve the registration. You will be notified by email once this is complete. Orders that have been submitted with a Bank Transfer payment method will not be approved until the associated payment has been received and reconciled.

Note that you can review your Order and registration(s) status by selecting the **Orders** option from the top right-hand corner Profile menu.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Has the Abbotsford Juniors registration process changing this year?

The registration process for Abbotsford Juniors is via the Dribl Registration system. There are some changes to process which this guide attempts to detail. Registration in PlayFootball is no longer required for all Clubs within the Football Canterbury Association.



2. What makes up the Abbotsford Juniors Registration Fee?

Our registration fees are made up of several components charged by a number of different parties including a Football Australia player fee, a Football NSW player fee and Football NSW insurance fee and Football Canterbury Association fees. Fees charged by Abbotsford Juniors go towards pitch lease and hire costs, lighting costs, player jerseys and playing kits along with other maintenance costs for Club equipment including goals, balls, nets and operating expenses.

3. What age group do I (or my child) register in?

It is important that junior and youth players are registered in their correct age group. In the Football Canterbury Association competition, junior and youth player age groups are based on the age a player will turn in 2022, regardless of the day or month they are born. By way of an example, a player born on 20th March 2011 will turn 11 in 2022 and so the player should be registered to play in the Under 11 age group.

Players should not register for a higher age group unless by arrangement with a Coach or Team Manager directly with the Club's Committee or as part of team selection through the Abbotsford Juniors Football Club's Team trials.

4. Can I add my child's Active Kids Voucher after completing registration?

An NSW Government Active Kids Voucher <u>cannot</u> be added after registration is complete and so you should not proceed if you plan on using a voucher and have not yet obtained one. In addition, once an NSW Government Active Kids Voucher is used with a submitted registration request, neither Abbotsford Juniors or Service NSW are able to provide a refund, including for reasons of change of mind or mistaken submission. You should seriously reconsider the use of the voucher if there is any reason why you might wish to cancel your registration.

5. What payment methods are available?

Abbotsford Juniors Football Club offers registration fee payment by credit card and bank (electronic funds) transfer.

6. How do I pay by Bank (Electronic Funds) Transfer?

Selecting **Bank Transfer** as the payment method for your registration request will trigger the system to send an email with instructions on how to make your payment. Please be sure to provide the Reference Number from your registration request email with your payment to ensure the Club can reconcile your payment. A failure to provide this information will likely delay the approval of your registration request.

7. Can I request a refund if I cancel my registration?

You can request a cancellation of your registration by sending an email to <u>registrar@abbotsfordjuniorsfc.com.au</u>. Refunds will not be granted after the commencement of the competition season.
